

Let Your Students Draw

lesson 11

I will mention here just a couple of ideas on ways to let your students draw in favour of their learning. I am sure that you can think of numerous other ways of using the creative potential of our students.

- **MIND MAP**
 - **to summarise the results of a research they've made**
 - **To plan a school event**
 - **To review and sum up a whole unit of lessons and so to prepare for an exam**
- **EMPATHY MAP**
 - **Let your students create an empathy map of their favourite book character/ football player/ best friend/ family member/ politician etc. There are limitless possibilities, depending on what areas of life you are exploring together with your students.**
- **TIMELINE**
 - **Let them reflect on their own lives and make a time line with the most important events of their life's journey so far**
 - **Let them create a time line about the history of your school or about the life of their class: When did they first met as a class? What were the most unforgettable experience they've had? What were the ups and downs? Where do they stand now?**
- **COMIC BOOK**
 - **Encourage your students to draw comics on a period of history you are working on**
 - **Let them invent a character who will guide them through the content. Let them draw a story of what this character would say about a certain topic you've worked on or that you plan to explore together.**
